

Supporting Carers at Work: A Line Managers' Guide

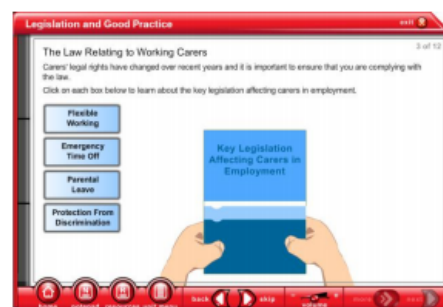
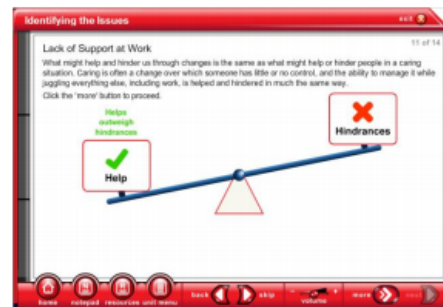
